HOW DOES IT WORK?

Willow City Farm will come to your location, and set up our secure metal fencing (and ground tarps if indoors) to keep the goats secure during yoga. Our fencing dimensions are flexible, so we can work with any shape that may be needed.

At maximum capacity, we can fit about 40 people per session in 1024 sq ft of fencing. An average class size is 30 people. We like to bring about 1 goat per 3 people, and our preference is to be mostly on grass, as it keeps the goats busy, and our area clean!

HOW LONG ARE WE THERE?

We prefer to set the sessions for 11am, 12pm, and 1pm. The 12pm and 1pm session are only added if it is clear the earlier classes will reach at least 25 people. If your business has different hours, no problem. We can work with you!

We arrive about 1.5 hours before the first session to set up, and tear down takes us about the same.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

Your venue does not pay WCF to come, and we don't pay you to be there. We will do the marketing, and just ask that you help share the event on your social media platforms. We will sell the tickets on our website. Tickets are usually \$40/per person; however, this can vary if the event is working with a local charity or it is held as a fundraiser. The goal is to get 50 – 100 potential new customers to your venue that would not normally be there! If you're an alcoholic establishment like a bar, winery or brewery, WCF will pay for one drink for each customer. It's included in the price of their ticket. The hope is that they stay and have a few more, or bring friends!

HOW DOES CHECK IN WORK?

WCF needs a small registration area, preferably away from the goats. Once people arrive, we check them in and have them sign a waiver. Once their waiver is signed, we give them a drink ticket and wristband. They can shop, get drinks, and wait in the registration area until the class begins. We explain what they can expect, general rules, and logistics. The class will move to the goat yoga area and begin. If there are more sessions, we remain at the registration table to move in the next group. Unfortunately, we don't allow spectators in most cases, so we do require everyone in the goat yoga area to have a wristband.

WHAT HAPPENS IN CLASS?

The first and last 10 - 15 minutes of class are spent playing with the goats and getting JUST the right photos! (Let's be honest. It's why they are all here!)

There's about 30-35 minutes of actual yoga instruction, but students are welcome to get serious with their yoga practice or just keep playing with the animals.

When all sessions are done, we'll secure the goats in the air-conditioned van, tear down the fencing and registration, and clean everything up! We'll pay our tab and take the goats back home!

ALCOHOL SALES

(*Only applies to businesses that sell alcohol.)
Willow City Farm provides each participant a drink
ticket. When they order their drink, we ask that you
keep the ticket and put the drink on a tab for WCF. At
the end of the event, WCF will pay the bar tab + tips.

We give each participant a drink ticket regardless of age, so they are welcome to order a non-alcoholic drink. It is the responsibility of the bar to check appropriate IDs. We ask that you have the bar ready at least 30 minutes before the first session.

LIABILITY

Willow City Farm is fully insured to hold Goat Yoga and petting zoos. Each participant must sign a waiver, and that waiver will include your business's legal name. If you would like to be listed as an additional insured on our policy for the event, no problem. Just ask us at the time of booking as it takes about 2 weeks to get the rider back from the underwriter. If you would like a copy of the waiver, just let us know and we'll get it to you.

ARE THE ANIMALS MESSY?

Everyone asks! It turns out our goats are NOT potty trained; they're real farm animals living on a real farm. But don't worry! Goat poop is just small pellets. It does not smell, and it's actually good fertilizer for grass. If the goats are to poop at yoga, the students just simply brush the pellets away. Should there be any larger mess, our staff cleans it up. We bring wet wipes, bleach water, cleaning spray, and hand sanitizer, too. To be honest, the biggest cleanup we usually have is just a split drink or two, and nope... we have never had a goat actually poop on anyone!

SEASONAL ANIMALS

Our sessions vary by season. We have goats year-round, but the pups, baby goats and piglets have a short window for yoga. Pups come in spring or fall, so the classes are limited. Baby goats are born in late winter/spring so the early March/April sessions get the newborns. Piglets are born year-round, but nature is unpredictable!

Since we book well in advance, we will schedule your session as goat or piglet yoga. If we happen to have pups or piglets, we'll be sure to give you the option for them to come if you'd like!

We'll even help collect money and supplies for the shelter
or rescue organization as well!
